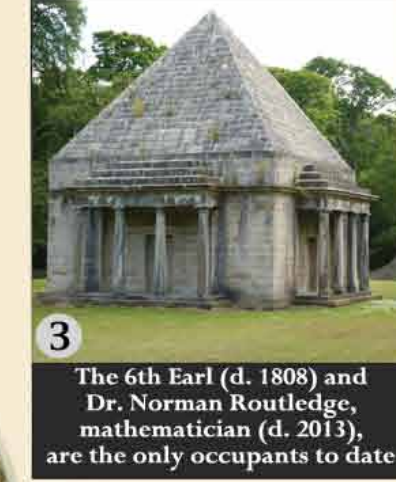

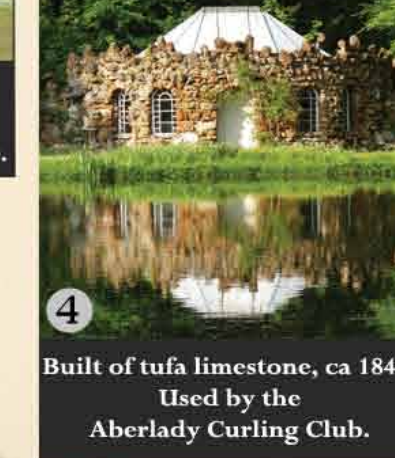

**Mausoleum**



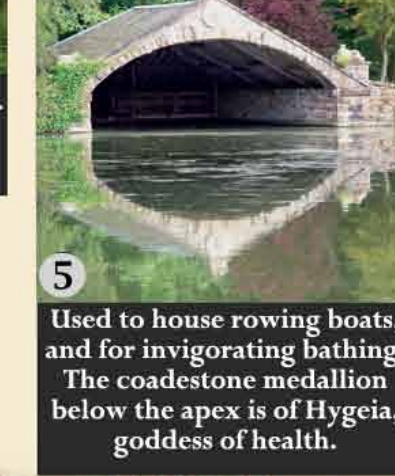

**Curling House**



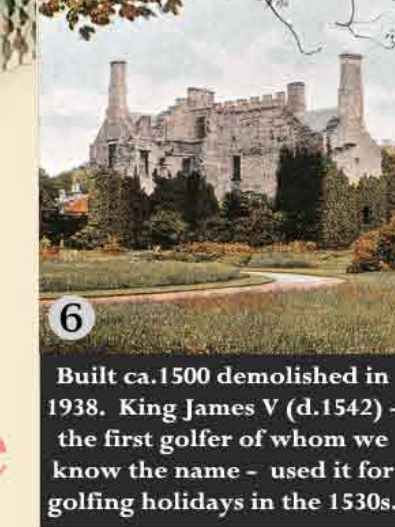
